- ✓ Are the fixture counts correct and fixtures labeled?
- ✓ Are there emergency fixtures, controls, and inverters?
- ✓ Are there any discrepancies in the fixture descriptions?
- ✓ Is there conflict between the Architectural and Electrical Sheets?
- ✓ Are any plan revisions understood by all stakeholders?
- ✓ Are all part numbers listed on plans up to date?
- ✓ Are the emergency fixtures shown on the plans?
- ✓ Is there site lighting such as poles, heads, wall packs, etc?
- ✓ Does everything correspond with the lighting designers overview?
